

2 Carriage Vertical Stripe Tuck Stitch Scarf



Machine: Mid-gauge

Yarn: Worsted weight. 200 yds variegated and 200 yds solid color

Size: 8" wide x 52" long

Notes:

1. Always pull up the slack in the tension mast before starting with the next carriage.
2. Hold the knitting against the bed when pulling the needles to hold position.
3. At the end of the first row with the next carriage, wrap the yarn under the needle that is in hold.
4. Both carriages remain in hold until instructed otherwise.

Holding position: Singer/Silver Reed – D; Brother – E.

UWP (upper working position): Singer/Silver Reed – C; Brother – D.

Directions

Even number of needles:

Cast on 32 sts with waste yarn. K several rows, ending with COL.

K 1 R ravel cord.

Thread SOLID yarn in the right mast. Thread the RIGHT carriage.

RC000. Tension 9. K 1 R. Using the 1 x 1 pusher, starting with the first needle on the left, pull EON to hold. SET LEVERS TO HOLD.

RC001. Tension 7. K 1 R.

Place the second carriage on the left. SET LEVERS TO HOLD and Tension 7.

Thread the LEFT carriage with VARIEGATED yarn.

*Using the flat side of the pusher, push the needles that are in hold to UWP.

Using the 1 x 1 side, pull the alternate needles to hold while holding the knitting against the bed.*

RC002. LEFT carriage. K 1 R. Wrap yarn under the last needle on the right.
K 1 R.
RC004. RIGHT carriage. Alternate the needles * to *.
K 1 R. Wrap yarn under the last needle on left. K 1 R.
RC006. LEFT carriage. Alternate the needles * to *. Repeat RC002.
RC008. RIGHT carriage. Alternate needles * to *. Repeat RC004.

Continue to desired length, alternating needles and carriages every 2 rows.

Ending: End after the LEFT carriage sequence. Be sure you have enough SOLID color to knit 2 rows.

Last two rows: RIGHT carriage. Alternate needles * to *. K 1 R only.

Cancel hold levers. Tension 9. Pull ALL needles to hold. Close latches. K 1 R, releasing the tension on the yarn coming from the mast, every few stitches. This will create larger stitches for a looser bind off.

Bind off loop-through-loop.

Bind off loop-through-loop, the first row that is on ravel cord.

Block if desired.

Did you leave your knitting to have lunch and return to discover you don't know what to do next? Look at the needles. If half the needles are in B position and the other half are in D/E position and have 2 threads of yarn on them, alternate the needles * to * and use the carriage holding the color that is different than the needles with 2 threads of yarn. Or, before walking away, alternate the needles and write a note which carriage to use next.

This can be made with one carriage only by threading the carriage with the alternate color every 2 rows.

K – knit
R – row/rows
EON – every other needle

COR – carriage on right
COL – carriage on left
